Journey by elegant train to Glacier National Park, where you'll wind along the breathtaking Going to the Sun Road aboard a classic red open-air "jammer" bus. On the impressive Missouri River, glide through the Gates of the Mountains, a highlight of Lewis and Clark's legendary westward expedition.

You'll cruise the mirror-like waters of Lake McDonald and float on the sublimely scenic Snake River, ever-watched by the dramatic silhouette of the Grand Teton range. In timeless Jackson, soak up the exhilarating atmosphere of the Old West, and in intriguing Salt Lake City, applaud the architectural jewels of Temple Square. Whether watching majestic bison roam or spouts of steam gush skyward, this uncommon journey will bring you closer than ever to the miraculous wonders of the west.

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DAY 1 | DEPART SEATTLE ABOARD THE GREAT WESTERN LIMITED

Board the *Great Western Limited* in Seattle this afternoon and enjoy a welcome reception while riding alongside Puget Sound, a delightful start to your elegant holiday. Later, partake in a delicious dinner as you cross the Cascade Mountains. Spend the night onboard, eastbound on the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway. (R,D)

DAY 2 | GLACIER NATIONAL PARK

Pull into Glacier National Park and transfer to a historic red open-air “jammer” bus for a spellbinding day traversing the Going to the Sun Road, a gorgeous drive over the Continental Divide (weather permitting). Enjoy an afternoon boat cruise on shimmering Lake McDonald before checking into the storied Izaak Walton Inn, a charming and intimate hotel built just before the start of WWII by the Great Northern Railroad. (B)

DAY 3 | GATES OF THE MOUNTAINS & BOZEMAN

Relax during a picturesque drive south, stopping for a boat cruise through the Missouri River’s Gates of the Mountains, a site described by Lewis & Clark on their epic trip west and a highlight of the trip. Afterward, continue south to historic Helena, MT for your overnight stay. (B,D)

DAY 4 | YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK

After a brief morning drive, arrive at the North Entrance of Yellowstone National Park for an all-day tour including the Upper Loop and awe-inspiring Mammoth Falls — be sure to your camera handy! In late afternoon you’ll

arrive to West Yellowstone for the first of two nights in this alluring small frontier town. (B)

DAY 5 | YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK

Arise for further exploration of America’s first National Park, discovering visual feasts such as Lower Falls, Hayden Valley, Old Faithful, Fountain Paint Pot and the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone,

Later today, arrive in the quintessential old west town of Jackson, Wyoming for a overnight stay with plenty of free time. Be sure to check out the famed Million Dollar Cowboy Bar and the antler arch across the street. (B)

DAY 7 | JACKSON, WY

This morning, thrill to a gentle float trip on the Snake River, with the dramatic Teton Range as your constant companion. At the Jackson Hole mountain resort, take in panoramic views of the Tetons as they soar into the sky, with the highest peak at 13,770 feet. After lunch, enjoy a scenic drive south to Salt Lake City, where superb rooms await at the renowned Little America Hotel, where we begin our two night stay. (B,L)

DAY 8 | LAKESIDE LIMITED & TEMPLE SQUARE

Journey east to the historic Heber Valley Railroad for a trip aboard the Lakeside Limited, a relaxing two-hour train ride along the shores of Deer Creek Reservoir and the base of imposing Mt. Timpanogos. Back in Salt Lake City, visit the famed Mormon Temple and Temple Square before our hosted farewell dinner. (B,D)

DAY 9 | RETURN HOME

If you wish, extend your stay in Salt Lake City or travel home by air. Alternatively, Amtrak’s California Zephyr train offers services west to California points and east to Chicago and Midwest points from Salt Lake City. (B)

One of the many delights of this holiday is our voyage through the stunning Gates of the Mountains on the Missouri River near Helena. From both sides of the river, limestone cliffs rise to a spectacular height of 1200 feet. During the epic Lewis & Clark exploration west, of this site Meriweather Lewis wrote "the rocks seem ready to tumble on us" and now over 200 years later, this spectacular sight looks the same. Our two-hour cruise takes us past towering walls of limestone where Bighorn sheep and mountain goats scamper in the rocks high above the water. Ospreys, eagles, vultures and falcons still soar overhead and black bears, mountain lions and deer call the canyon home. Almost every tour to Glacier Park and Yellowstone misses the Gates of the Mountain, yet we would never dream of missing it and expect you will agree.
