

Built by the Budd Company in 1947 as a tavern lounge car for what New York Central Railroad rightly called its 'Great Steel Fleet,' this elegant and spacious car has been restored to its art deco glory with comfortable seating, stylish furnishings and a separate tavern area for light meals. With an attentive staff and welcoming amenities like Mimosas, Afternoon Tea and smart cocktail hours, travel is a treat aboard this car today the same way it was in the 1950's when assigned to crack trains like the *Pacemaker*, *Commodore Vanderbilt* and the *New England States*.
