DAY 3 TUE SEP 24 ROCKLAND, ME

Rockland sits in wonderful Knox County in Maine, almost exactly midway between historic Portland to the south and Bar Harbor to the north, on a stretch of typically picturesque New England coastline. Enjoy the patchworks of hills and fields inland, and the grandeur of the rocky coast with pounding Atlantic waves, from what many call the 'gateway to Penobscot Bay'.

DAY 4 WED SEP 25 HALIFAX, NS

Behold the star-shaped fortress that stands guard to this fascinating city where, in summer, a band plays the bagpipes while a cannon is still fired ceremoniously each day at noon. Come view tradition as it lives on today.

Almost 400 miles northeast of Quebec City, Sept-iles stands proud in the Cote-Nord region, where roads are scarce. Look over the St. Lawrence River as it widens into the mighty Gulf of St Lawrence.

DAY 7 SAT SEP 28 SAGUENAY, QC

With its rugged nature and quaint town, Saguenay is enchanting. Discover the history of this remote region and its museums, interpretation centres, artists workshops and tourist sites.

DAY 8 SUN SEP 29 QUEBEC, QC

Glide into picture-perfect Quebec City, a UNESCO World Heritage site. An included sightseeing tour features Montmorency Falls, the famed Citadel and the Old Town. A special treat today is included lunch at a stylish Quebecois restaurant. Tonight is our first of a two night hotel stay in this charming city.

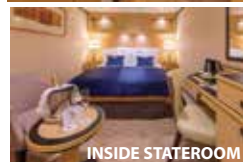
