Day 1: Friday, August 9 | Boston, MA

Arrive Boston and transfer to the hotel to begin your two-night stay at the legendary Omni Parker House Hotel.

Day 2: Saturday, Aug 10 | Boston, MA

An all day visit to Cape Cod with stops at Hyannis Port and Martha's Vineyard. We travel to Cape Cod aboard the *Cape Flyer* train and have included lunch with Lobster Rolls today in this lovely setting with white beaches and lighthouses. B L

Day 3: Sunday, August 11 | Boston, MA

All morning to further explore Boston since we do not depart the hotel until 1pm for the nearby pier and the Emerald Princess. B

Ship sails at 4:00 PM

Day 4: Monday, Aug 12 | At Sea

Day 5: Tuesday, Aug 13 | Sydney, Canada

Port of Sydney is fabled as a magical destination known for its beauty and unique Celtic music and culture.

Arrive 8:00 AM Depart 5:00 PM

Day 6: Wednesday, Aug 14 | At Sea

Day 7: Thursday, Aug 15 | Corner Brook, Canada

Corner Brook is located on the west coast of Newfoundland nestled among the Long Range Mountains. The coastline is filled with great fjords, thick forests and jagged headlands.

Arrive 8:00 AM Depart 5:00 PM

Day 8: Friday, Aug 16 | At Sea

Day 9: Saturday, Aug 17 | At Sea

Day 10: Sunday, Aug 18 | Nuuk, Greenland

Nuuk is the island's capital and largest city, at about 16,000 people. Settled in 1728, it lies on a peninsula along the central west coast and is the gateway to an extensive system of fjords. Like most places in Greenland, it displays magnificent vistas of mountains and valleys.

Arrive 8:00 AM Depart 6:00 PM

New York City Pre-cruise option:

For guests that would like to spend time in New York City before sailing, we offer a nice two-night package beginning August 9th with a two-night hotel stay including tax and on August 11th, a speedy trip to Boston on the Acela train in Business Class, America's fastest train right from Penn Station in midtown Manhattan. Day 11: Monday, Aug 19 | At Sea

Day 12: Tuesday, Aug 20 | Qaqortoq, Greenland

Qaqortoq means "White Palace" in Greenlandic, and this small town of about 3,400 is the cultural and commercial center of Southern Greenland. Inuit and then Europeans were drawn to the site over 200 years lured by the wealth of marine mammals that thrive in the offshore waters during summer.

Arrive 7:00 AM Depart 6:00 PM

Day 13: Wednesday, Aug 21 | Nanortalik, Greenland

Nanortalik means "place of bears" in Greenlandic. Summer visitors to this extraordinary - and extraordinarily isolated - port may spot polar bears on the offshore flow ice. Those offshore waters also teem with seals and Minke, humpback and fin whales.

Arrive 7:00 AM Depart 6:00 PM

Day 14: Thursday, Aug 22 | At Sea

Day 15: Friday, Aug 23 | At Sea

Day 16: Saturday, Aug 24 | St. Anthony, Newfoundland

Welcome to the Port of St. Anthony, a tranquil fishing town nestled on the tip of beautiful Newfoundland. Centuries ago, Norse sailors explored these shores, establishing a trading colony that echoes through time.

Arrive 7:00 AM Depart 4:00 PM

Day 17: Sunday, Aug 25 | St. John's, Newfoundland

St John's has always been a busy fishing port with a good natural harbor bounded by hills. Its history and cultural spirit show strong Irish and Scottish influences evident in its pubs and music.

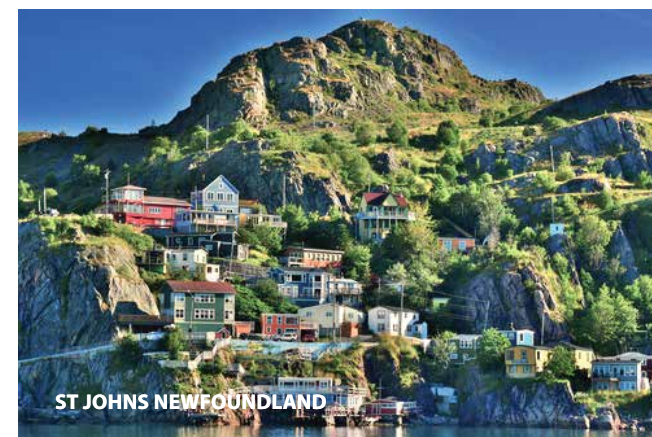
Arrive 9:00 AM Depart 6:00 PM

Guest disembark and begin their travel home.

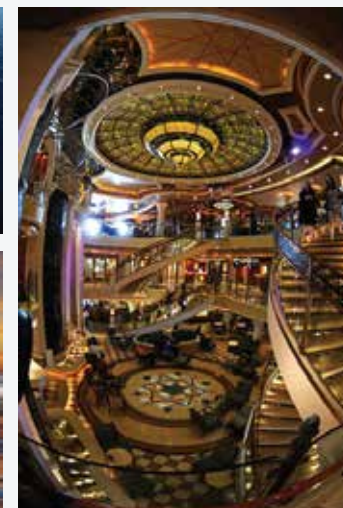
