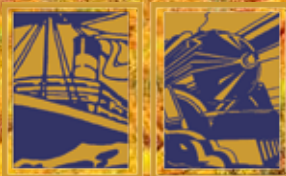

Condensed Daily Itinerary

1 Sep 25 WED LD

All aboard! We depart Boston this morning aboard the Downeaster train bound for Portland, Maine and upon arrival, enjoy a ride along the harbor aboard the Maine Narrow Gauge Railroad, a nice beginning to our holiday. Later we arrive in North Conway with time to explore the quaint downtown before our casual welcome dinner.

2 Sep 26 THU BL

A special treat awaits today with travel aboard the Mountaineer train of the Conway Scenic Railroad through Mount Washington Valley and over Crawford Notch. Many believe this the prettiest train ride in the East and later today we visit North Conway Village with the evening at leisure to enjoy as you like.

3 Sep 27 FRI BL

Today offers a scenic drive to Lake Winnepesaukee with a special treat, a lake cruise aboard the steamboat 'Mount Washington'. Later today, a visit to Kellerhaus, the oldest candy and ice cream maker in New Hampshire for a relaxing yet delicious day.

4 Sep 28 SAT BL

Saving the best for last, today reaches a new high with a trip aboard the famed Mt Washington Cog Railway to the top of Mt Washington with views in every direction from the highest mountain in the East. Later, we visit to legendary Omni Mt Washington Hotel & Resort with lunch at this historic property with its incredible views of the Presidential Mountains from its 900 foot long

Veranda. Later, we visit charming Littleton, a small town filled with boutiques, galleries, local eateries and breweries. Not to be missed is Main Street and the Bridge Walk including a 325 foot long covered bridge. Our final evening is spent in North Conway tonight.

5 Sep 29 SUN BL

The Big day! We depart for the most fabled ship afloat after breakfast with lunch in Quebec City and a tour of this UNESCO world heritage site and the only walled city in North America before boarding Queen Mary 2 this afternoon. Happily the ship is your hotel tonight docked in the shadow of the famous Chateau Frontenac Hotel.

6 Sep 30 MON

All day to further enjoy Quebec City with a late afternoon departure for New York. Be sure to be on deck as the great liner leaves the pier with all of Quebec City passing before us.

7 Oct 1 TUE

Queen Mary 2 cruises the St Lawrence River today with plenty of time to explore the greatest ship of our time including the largest library and Planetarium afloat, a huge array of restaurants and bars, a casino, a superb spa and acres of open deck.

8 Oct 2 WED

Queen Mary 2 visits Sydney today, on beautiful Cape Breton Island and home to, among other things, the world's biggest fiddle. Cape Breton Island is famed for its friendliness and we are certain you will soon agree.

9 Oct 3 THU

A final day at sea to relax and enjoy the Queen Mary 2. A fine day to enjoy that most British of traditions, afternoon tea or perhaps a pint of ale in the Golden Lion Pub. Tonight is our farewell cocktail party and a final chance to take in a show, a live music performance or a drink in the bar, our favorite location being the Commodore Club, high atop the ship overlooking the bow.

10 Oct 4 FRI

We dock in New York and disembark after breakfast. For guests traveling home by train, we provide a complimentary shuttle to Penn Station in midtown Manhattan.

While in North Conway, two more extraordinary train rides are included, the Mountaineer train through Mt Washington Valley and over Crawford Notch, often called the most scenic train ride in the East and even rarer, a trip on the famed Mt Washington Cog Railway to the top of Mt

Washington. Of course, other treats are included like a historic steamboat trip on Lake Winnepesaukee, a visit to charming Littleton with its Bridge Walk and covered bridge and much more. As always, all sightseeing and admission fees are included and we have left plenty of free time for you to enjoy things at your own pace.

After our four-night New Hampshire stay we drive north to Quebec City and board the last great ocean liner afloat, RMS Queen Mary 2 for a rare mini-cruise to New York City. We have a full 28 hours in Quebec City using the ship as our hotel before sailing down the St Lawrence River, stopping in Sydney, Nova Scotia on lovely Cape Breton Island on our way to New York City. Onboard, guests enjoy the style, heritage and service that has made Cunard the benchmark for ocean travel since 1840. While plenty of cruise ships offer Canada & New England cruises there is only one great Queen liner and everyone should enjoy this celebrated ocean liner at least once.
