### Day 5: Wednesday, July 16 | Halifax, Canada

Historic Halifax greets us this morning and nearby Peggy's Cove is the most photographed sight in all of Canada.

### Day 6: Thursday, July 17 | Sydney, Canada

Cape Breton is fabled as a magical travel destination, known for its beauty and unique Celtic music and culture. Sydney is also the gateway to the Fortress of Louisbourg, the largest historic reconstruction in North America.

### Day 7: Friday, July 18 | At Sea

### Day 8: Saturday, July 19 | St. John's Newfoundland CA

St John's has always been a busy fishing port with a natural harbor bounded by hills. Its history and cultural spirit show strong Irish and Scottish influence in its pubs and music.

Nanortalik means "place of bears" in Greenlandic. Summer

visitors to this extraordinary - and isolated - port may spot polar bears on the offshore flow ice. The offshore waters also teem with seals and Minke, humpback and fin whales.

### Day 12: Wednesday, July 23 | Qaqortoq, Greenland

Qaqortoq means 'White Palace' in Greenlandic, and this small town of about 3,400 is the cultural and commercial center of Southern Greenland. Inuit and then Europeans were drawn to the site over 200 years ago lured by the wealth of marine mammals that thrive in the offshore waters during summer.

### Day 13: Thursday, July 24 | At Sea

### Day 14: Friday, July 25 | Paamiut, Greenland

Home to the largest population of white-tailed eagles (Natto-ralik) in Greenland, Paamiut is a well-kept secret. Much like the eagles that soar overhead, this little-visited destination is a delight. The colorful, historic houses that tell stories of whaling and fur trading quickly give way to a backcountry crisscrossed with ancient trails.

### Day 15: Saturday, July 26 | Nuuk, Greenland

Nuuk is the island's capital and largest city, at about 16,000 people. Settled in 1728, it lies on a peninsula along the central west coast and is the gateway to an extensive system of fjords. Like most places in Greenland, it displays magnificent vistas of mountains and valleys.
