### Panama Canal

As you pass through the locks at either side of Gatun Lake, you're slowly rising to, and dropping from, 85 feet above sea level, avoiding the lengthy and treacherous alternative route via Cape Horn.

Situated on the Pacific coastline, 67 miles south of Guatemala City, Puerto Quetzal is one of the major ports serving the Central American country.
